Richard Grossman, MD, Course Medical Director, announces the Advanced Burn Life Support Provider Course to be held **February 4, 2006** from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. in the **Grossman Burn Center at Sherman Oaks Hospital, 4929 Van Nuys Boulevard, Sherman Oaks, California.** You and/or members of your staff are invited to participate in this Advanced Burn Life Support Course.

The **Advanced Burn Life Support Provider Course** is an eight-hour course for physicians, nurses, physician assistants, nurse practitioners, therapists, and paramedics. The course provides guidelines in the assessment and management of the burn patient during the first 24 hours post injury. Following a series of lectures, case studies are presented for group discussions. You will be given the opportunity to work with a simulated burn patient to reinforce the assessment, stabilization, and the American Burn Association transfer criteria to a Burn Center. Final testing consists of a written exam and a practical assessment. The registration fee covers the tuition, manual, study guide, test, and continuing education credits.

The American Burn Association is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education to provide continuing medical education for physicians. The ABA designates this continuing medical education activity for up to 7 credit hours in Category 1 of the Physician's Recognition Award of the American Medical Association. Each physician should claim only those hours of credit he/she actually spent in the educational activity.

This program does not provide for Paramedic CE under a national program, however, we will submit documentation to work with local providers for continuing education credits.
